**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 06-228 (AM)**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING THE SCOPE AND APPLICABILITY OF MSB 17.63 RACE TRACK REGULATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Borough Code.

Section 2. Amendment of section: MSB 17.63.005 is hereby amended by adding the following definition:

"One-time annual race" means a race which occurs annually, but only once per year.

Section 3. Amendment of section: MSB 17.63.015 is hereby amended as follows:

(E) One-time annual races are exempt from the provisions of this chapter, but may be subject to a special events permit as outlined in MSB 8.55 Special Events.

(F) Race tracks/courses that are used for more than three (3) days for motorized vehicle races within any twelve (12) consecutive month period must be authorized by a conditional use permit in accordance with this chapter.

(G) Race tracks/courses that are used by motorized

vehicles for more than seven (7) days within any twelve (12) consecutive month period for practice for motorized vehicle races must be authorized by a conditional use permit in accordance with this chapter.

(H) Races which are not conducted on a permanent facility are exempt from the provisions of this chapter.

Section 4. Amendment of paragraph: MSB 17.63.020(I)(8) is hereby amended as follows:

(8) Motorized race activities may, on permanent tracks, be permitted between May 15 and September 15 within hours of operations between 10 a.m. and 10 p.m. The planning commission may restrict motorized race track activities to certain days or hours of operation, Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays, and national holidays.

Section 5. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly.
